Public Health launches COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

The Public Health Department will launch the COVID-19 National Vaccination Campaign on Friday 8th January 2021.

The National Vaccination Plan outlines different groups in the community to be vaccinated based on vulnerability and potential exposure to COVID-19. The vaccinations will be free and available to persons in Stage 1, Group A (see attached for all Stages & Groups).

Public Health have organised on-site vaccinations for residents and staff of institutional facilities, frontline staff dealing with incoming travellers and healthcare workers from the private hospitals.
