



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

His Excellency the Governor Mr. Martyn Roper, OBE, chaired the meeting of the Cabinet held on Tuesday, 3rd August 2021 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

All Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- approved the Cayman Islands Coast Guard Bill, 2021;
- approved the issuance of a coastal works license for a private residential dock above Crown property offshore Block 33M Parcel 10;
- approved the issuance of drafting instructions as provided by the National Conservation Council for formal draft Regulations to be produced under Section 50 of the National Conservation Act, 2013;
- approved a transfer of allocation to the Ministry of Education for education, early childhood and support services;
- approved the purchase of land, for the purpose of constructing a new retirement home in East End;
- approved the purchase of a private road parcel for peppercorn consideration for public use and a 30 foot vehicular Right of Way in Little Cayman;
- advised His Excellency the Governor that approval be given for the sale of 2 crown properties;
- approved the submission of the National Drug Council Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements for the year ending 31st December 2020 to the House of Parliament;
- approved the Commencement Order of the Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 2021;
- approved the appointment of Mr. Osbourne Bodden as Chair, Mr. Jaron Leslie as Deputy Chair, Ms. Nanalie Cover as Director, Dr Luana Look Loy as Director, Ms. Tresea Brown as Director, Mr. Tayvis Walters as Director, and Ms. Joy Vernon as Director to the Health Services Authority Board; and
- noted the update on Stony Coral Tissue Loss Disease in the Cayman Islands.
