Good afternoon,

I appreciate all the arrangements and planning being done rapidly given the very tight timescales. This is largely due to the fact that the Minister was only made aware of and invited to the trade show planned for Friday, 24, by the president of the Honduran chamber of commerce on Wednesday, 15th June. It should also be noted that attending this show and establishing a relationship with the chamber of commerce is in furtherance of the Minister's stated priority of enhancing trade links between Cayman and neighboring jurisdictions as described in the draft Food and Nutrition Security Policy.

The Minister has decided to accept the invitation. I understand flight options have been considered and the most economic and less complicated method is the direct flight by Cayman Airways. However CAL only travels to Honduras on Mondays and Fridays. I am told that the itinerary from Monday to Thursday is being facilitated and organized by Caymanian business persons who already have established trade relationships with businesses in Honduras.

Friday and the weekend are being organized by the Honduran Chamber of Commerce.

I am told the Minister has also invited the Speaker of the House to accompany him on this trip.

Please ensure that all plans and arrangements made are well within the travel policy and any other legislation/policy which govern these matters.

Good Afternoon Honorable Speaker Bush,

On behalf of the Hon. Minister, Johany "Jay" Ebanks, I write to extend an invite to be a part of the delegation traveling to Honduras on June 20th 2022.

This travel is at the invite of the Chamber of Commerce (La Ceiba), to attend an Expo on June 24th, 2022. The delegation will also travel to San Pedro Sula, at the invitation of a private sector entity (Cayman Imports), to tour various facilities/processing centers in that region of the country.

We are in the early stages of formalizing the itinerary, as we are awaiting information from the Chamber of Commerce in La Ceiba.

It is anticipated that the delegation will fly in to San Pedro Sula, via La Ceiba, on June 20th. In concluding the various tours in San Pedro Sula, the delegation will fly back to La Ceiba on June 23rd, to attend the Expo on June 24th (and, possibly, various meetings will follow thereafter).

The delegation will then return to Grand Cayman on June 27th, 2022.
