SUBJECT: Section 49 of the Police Law (2017 Revision) Permission to

impose curfew

WHEREAS you have represented to me that you are of the opinion that there are reasonable grounds to believe that in the interest of public safety and/or public order, it is necessary to impose curfews throughout the Islands of Grand Cayman and Cayman Brac commencing Friday 15 May 2020.

AND WHEREAS I have consulted with the Natural Hazard Management Executive and the Cabinet, pursuant to section 49(1) of the Police Law (2017 Revision) I hereby grant you permission to impose curfews on the following terms:

- 1. The permission granted herein shall be valid for eighteen (18) days commencing on Friday 15 May 2020 and ending on Tuesday 2 June 2020.
- 2. During the period Friday 15 May 2020 to Tuesday 2 June 2020, you may impose curfews between the hours of 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. or such other hours as you may deem necessary provided that any curfew period shall endure for no more than forty-eight (48) hours at any time.
- 3. Persons designated as essential personnel shall be exempted from any curfew imposed.

4. If after the expiration of the curfew on Tuesday 2 June 2020 you consider that there are reasonable grounds for imposing further curfews, you shall seek my further permission pursuant to section 49(1) of the Police Law (2017 Revision).
