#### **Key facts**

- Around 25% of students are attending 'good' or 'excellent' schools.
- One quarter of all schools are performing at the expected level for Cayman.
- Approximately 75% of students are attending schools that are judged to be not yet meeting the
  expected level of performance according to the OES 'Successful Schools and Achieving Students'
  criteria.
- More than 80% of Caymanian students are attending schools that are judged to be not yet meeting the expected level of performance according to the OES 'Successful Schools and Achieving Students' criteria.
- Only one government school was judged to be 'good'.
- Of the 13 schools whose overall performance was judged to be 'weak', three were revisited by OES and were found to have made satisfactory progress in addressing the recommendations from the last inspection.
- In the 2019 Annual Report, 'Every School a Good School', OES made a number of recommendations suggesting pathways to future success. There has been slow progress in addressing those recommendations.
