Regrettably, we, the undersigned independent members of the Legislature are compelled to write this letter in light of continued media utterances from you since our meetings where several of our concerns were brought to you.

As you may recall, your interview with Cayman News Service with the headline "Miller gives his backing to civil unions" which was posted on their website on February 20, 2019 caused great concern amongst the group and raised many issues with the people that we represent. It should be noted that although the article clearly stated that you spoke for yourself and not the Official Opposition Group – in the eyes of the public, you are seen as the Leader of the Opposition and the primary spokesperson for the Official Opposition Group.


In light of the recent ruling by the Chief Justice, your previous statement has continued to give pause to many of our constituents thus the need to provide you with this letter to highlight our concerns and our challenges.

We are cognizant that, like us, you are also the duly elected representative for the good people of North Side, and like us, you were also elected as an Independent member to the Legislative Assembly. We are also cognizant that this is the first time since the new Constitution that the Leader of the Opposition is an Independent versus the leader of a political party and this comes with its' own challenges.




