PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 3 of 2024-2025

Motion to acquire Red Spot, George Town (Block & Parcel # OPY5 and OPY7)

WHEREAS Caymanians in the fishing community who traditionally utilize Red Spot for economic opportunities are at risk of losing their prescriptive rights to this piece of land.

AND WHEREAS Red Spot is of significant importance to the heritage of the Cayman Islands.

AND WHEREAS Caymanians who utilize Red Spot for income generation are in dire need of stability to maintain their fishing pursuits and operations to contribute to the food security agenda of the Cayman Islands.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Government considers compulsory acquisition of Red Spot to facilitate and protect the continued sustenance of the fishing community of the Cayman Islands with the possibility of a fish market.
