In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Law (2002 Revision) the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation and commencement

- **1**. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) (Ticket) (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations, 2020.
 - (2) These Regulations come into force on 21st June, 2020.

Amendment of regulation 2 of the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) (Ticket) Regulations, 2020 – tickets for offences under the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulations, 2020

- **2**. The *Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) (Ticket) Regulations, 2020, in these Regulations referred to as the "principal Regulations", are amended in regulation 2 as follows —*
 - (a) by deleting the regulation heading and substituting the following heading —



"Tickets for offences under the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (No.2) Regulations, 2020"; and

(b) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words "regulation 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 of the *Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 Regulations, 2020*" and substituting the words "regulation 4, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 15, 16, 17 or 18 of the *Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (No.2) Regulations, 2020*".

Amendment of Schedule 1 - ticket under the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 Regulations, 2020

3. The principal Regulations are amended in Schedule 1 by deleting the subheading of the Schedule and substituting the following subheading —

"TICKET UNDER THE PREVENTION, CONTROL AND SUPPRESSION OF COVID-19 (PARTIAL LIFTING OF RESTRICTIONS) (NO.2) REGULATIONS, 2020".

Repeal and substitution of Schedule 2 - ticket offences and fines under the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 Regulations, 2020

4. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing Schedule 2 and substituting the following Schedule —
